Jason Schwarz is in his second year as head coach of the Berthold Bombers. Last year he guided the Bombers to a third place finish in District 12 and a Region 6 runner-up. This season the Bombers brought home the District 12 championship, their first in 21 years.

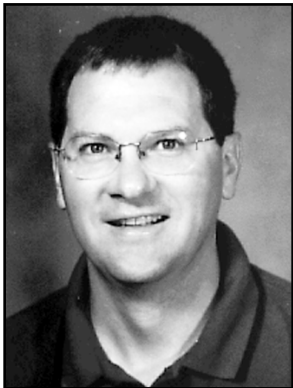
Coach Schwarz has previously coached boys' high school basketball in North Dakota, either as an assistant or a head coach in Des Lacs-Burlington, Wilton, and Lakota. While in Lakota, he also served as the head girls' basketball coach. Coach Schwarz was also an

Coach Schwarz graduated from Minot State University in 1995 with a bachelors degree in physical education and minors in business education, driver education, and coaching.

DICKINSON TRINITY HEAD COACH – Gregg Grinsteiner



Gregg Grinsteiner is in his 15th year coaching at Trinity High School. He is presently in his eighth year as head coach, having previously coached the freshmen and junior varsity squads.

Gregg is a 1982 graduate of Trinity High School and a 1987 graduate of Dickinson State University. He has taught math and coached at THS since the fall of 1987. Gregg has been involved as an assistant in the football program, coached junior high track, and was the head coach of the Dickinson Eagles Legion team for

three years. In 1999, he coached the Titans to their best finish since turning Class B when they finished second in the state tournament after getting beat by the eventual state champion Leeds 54-53. The Titans finished that year at 27-1. Last year the Titans finished third at the State B Tournament in Minot capping off a 24-4 year.

Gregg has been married since 1987. He and his wife, Carol, have four children: Amy (13), Aaron (10), Nicole (8), and Katelyn (5).

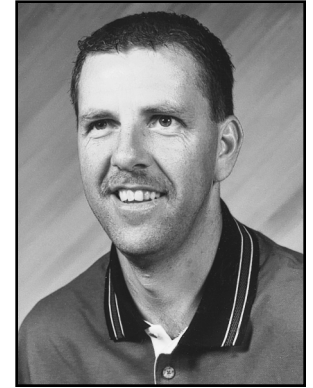
KINDRED HEAD COACH – Perry Piatz
